## Cleaner burning gasoline sold in major cities soon

**WASHINGTON (AP)**—Millions of American motorists will be burning cleaner gasoline this winter and hereafter. The tradeoff may be slightly higher prices at the pump.

By the first major federal law requiring "clean air" legislation that became law two years ago.

Beginning Sunday, service stations in 30 areas of the country, including most major cities, will be able to sell only gasoline that contains a special oxygen additive, allowing it to burn cleaner on our exhaust and put out less carbon monoxide.

"This is the first law program under the Clean Air Act to go into effect," said Dick Wilson of the Environmental Protection Agency. "It's the first time the public will actually notice."

The new gasoline will be required in cities and metropolitan areas that have the most serious health and death for carbon monoxide, a pollutant that comes largely from motor vehicles and is most severe in winter months when it takes longer to clear away.

The new gasoline blend must be used over a four-to-seven-month period, depending on the performance and length of the pollution problem. The EPA estimates that the cleaner gasoline will cut automotive carbon monoxide emissions by about 20 percent.

In high concentrations, carbon monoxide can be deadly. But even when taken into the blood stream in small amounts, it can inhibit oxygen

### Movie ratings

**LOS ANGELES (AP)**—The make up of a new Motion Picture Association board plans to release the annual film list, but the industry is still saying the new NC-17 mark has become controversial with parents.

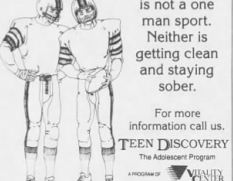
In a simultaneous development over the controversial rating, an unnamed director Louis Malle said he is leaving from film "Damage" and is not being shipped with the NC-17 classification.

The twin developments are only the first of a series of problems that may be in the making for the new NC-17 rating introduced two years ago, the rating has made the distribution of adult-oriented films increasingly problematic.

"I am stunned, just shocked," Malle, the director of "Atlantic City," said in a Thursday telephone interview. "If Malle had not cut an R, I think I'd have a PG-13. This is a very passionate movie. But there is no sex, there is no nudity."

"Body of Evidence," starring Madonna and William Baltus, was originally rated NC-17 by the ratings board of the Motion Picture Association of America.
